Fellowships for young climate experts

With the International Climate Protection Fellowships, the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation promotes prospective leaders from non-European transition and developing countries working in the field of climate protection. The fellows come to Germany for one year to conduct a research-related project of their own choice together with a host and collaborative partner. They receive up to 2,750 EUR per month plus benefits such as comprehensive family allowances, German tuition and a lump sum for travel expenses.

Applicants must be able to demonstrate clearly visible leadership potential and existing involvement with issues relating to the scientific, engineering, legal, economic or social aspects of climate change.

Up to 20 fellowships are granted annually, funded under the Federal Environment Ministry's (BMU) International Climate Initiative. The **closing date for applications** is **15 March 2014**.
